### Reading

### Maths - Short Division

This week we're going to recap how we use short division.

Before we begin, can you practise your mental oral division skills? Ask someone in your family to test you on some quick fire division questions.

E.g.  $15 \div 5 =$

$36 \div 6 =$

$99 \div 11 =$

$60 \div 12 =$

$27 \div 3 =$

$42 \div 7 =$

You could use your times tables grid in your home learning pack to help with this.
