Phonics

Once you have watched the video please could you get your child to read and spell the following words:

huge, brute, cube, June, rude, rule, excuse, flute, amuse

Once your child has done this, the challenge for today is to read the words in alien words. It is the PDF document called **Year 1 – 2.6 Tuesday u-e split diagraph real and alien words**

You could then complete some sentences using the real words in the sentence.


Maths

This is the first lesson on multiplication. We teach this as repeated addition and counting/adding groups together to give a total. Today we are focusing on counting in 2's, 5's and 10's. There are various songs on Youtube if you would like to complete it this way but otherwise counting on rote is fine. Today we have provided a sheet which requires your child to draw arrays to count them altogether. This sheet shows the x symbol. We would like to inform you that the x symbol **does not** mean groups of and lots of and should not be explained like this. In the calculation of 3×2 this is not 3 groups of 2 as the array would look completely different, this is 3 multiplied twice, this giving it a different array.

The below array shows 3 lots of 2



Whereas this array shows 3×2



This may seem as if it is a small matter but this creates a misconception and confuses children when solving problems as they get further on in their education. The PDF is attached as **Year 1– 2.6 Tues 2s 5s and 10s arrays**
