National Curriculum Objectives:

Mathematics Year 1: (1M4b) [Sequence events in chronological order using language \[for example, before and after, next, first, today, yesterday, tomorrow, morning, afternoon and evening\]](#)

Differentiation:

Questions 1, 4 and 7 (Varied Fluency)

Developing Sort the events into the correct place in the table to show understanding of 'before' and 'after' using the language; morning, afternoon and night.

Expected Sort the events into the correct place in the table to show understanding of 'before' and 'after' using the language; first, then, next, finally.

Greater Depth Sort the events into the correct place in the table to show understanding of before and after using the language; after, first, then, next, finally. Some open ended questions requiring children to draw on own experiences.

Questions 2, 5 and 8 (Varied Fluency)

Developing Order the events by matching the activities to the correct label to show understanding of 'before' and 'after' using the language; before and then.

Expected Order the events by matching the activities to the correct label to show understanding of 'before' and 'after' using the language; before and after.

Greater Depth Order the events by matching the activities to the correct label to show understanding of before and after using the language; then and finally. Some open ended questions requiring children to draw on own experiences.

Questions 3, 6 and 9 (Reasoning and Problem Solving)

Developing Decide which statement is correct and explain why to show understanding of 'before' and 'after' using the language; before, after, first, then, morning, afternoon or night.

Expected Decide which statement is correct and explain why to show understanding of 'before' and 'after' using the language; before, after, first, then, next, after, finally, morning, afternoon, evening or night.

Greater Depth Decide which statement is correct and explain why to show understanding of before and after using the language; before, after, first, then, next, after, finally, morning, afternoon, evening or night. Some open ended questions requiring children to draw on own experiences.

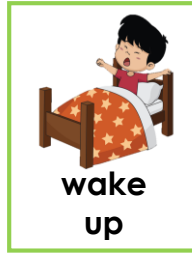

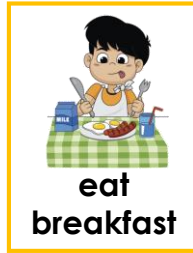

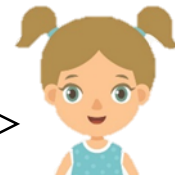
