ACTIVITY

Windmills and Tee Pees

- Using an area of your choice, participants would run around the area, or can also use different movements such as hop, skip etc.
- Whilst on the move participants arms would be swinging, can be forward, backwards or alternate like a windmill motion.
- When 'Tee Pee' is called, participants balance on one leg and hold their hands above their head.
- Once performed this move for approx 5 seconds the game continues.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED

- Space

MAKE IT EASIER...

Start with the balance just being on one leg.

MORE OF A CHALLENGE

Progress to one leg and then holding their hands above their head. See how long they can balance for.

MAKE IT INCLUSIVE

Any area can be used of your choice, different balances could be used if needed too such as; balancing an item on the palm of a hand.

LEAD OTHERS

Competition to see which family member can balance the longest.

Phonics Activity


Have a go at this balloon phonics game. There are different levels of difficulty so you can have a go at all three or try the harder level if they are a more confident reader.

Maths (Measuring short periods of time)

You can also include siblings with this activity and see how their times compare.
