



Multiplication Problems

- a) There are 26 pencils in a box. How many pencils are there in 3 boxes?
- b) Each car holds 4 people. How many people can fit in 16 cars?
- c) There are 6 eggs in each box. How many eggs are there in 35 boxes?
- d) Flowers are arranged so that there are 56 in each row. How many flowers are there 4 rows?
- e) Motorbikes have 2 wheels. How many wheels do 84 motorbikes have?
- f) Smarties are red, blue, green, yellow, pink, orange, purple and brown. If there are three of each colour, how many Smarties are there altogether?
- g) Tricycles have 3 wheels. How many wheels are there altogether if there are 29 tricycles?
- h) There are 24 biscuits and 3 children. How many biscuits can each child have?



Pronouns

A pronoun is a word that takes the place of a proper noun.

e.g. The children played in the park. The children came home early.

The children played in the park. They came home early.
